Renowned master drummer **Jorge Alabe** is an "Alabê", the highest level in drumming and master of ceremony in the Candomblé religion, of Casa Branca, the oldest Candomblé house established by Africans in Brazil. Jorge Alabê was the rhythm director of Minas Geraes Samba School in Belo Horizonte and a member of Padre Miguel Samba School in Rio de Janeiro and has performed in recordings, shows and classes with Brazilian star Milton Nascimento - Missa dos Quilombos and the afro-Brazilian historian Mercedes Batista, among others. For 15 years, he was the percussion director of the world-renowned Brazilian group Oba Oba, and toured through Europe, Asia, South America, and the U.S., including Broadway. Since 1995 Jorge has conducted workshops on Candomblé and Samba and led student groups throughout the U.S. Currently he is doing a residency with New Orleans first Escola de Samba, Casa Samba, under the direction of Curtis Pierre.
